



**Regulation No 63
of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences, of 24 May 2021
on the organization of the academic year 2021/2022**

According to Article 63(1) of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences Statute, it is hereby decreed as follows:

Article 1

The organization of the academic year 2021/2022 is hereby determined in the wording constituting appendix to the Regulation.

Article 2

The implementation of the Regulation has been assigned to the SGGW Deans, Vice-Deans, and Heads of organizational units.

Article 3

Supervision over the implementation of the Regulation has been assigned to the Vice-Rector for Didactics.

Article 4

The Regulation enters into force on the day of its signing, with effect from the day of 30 September 2021.

**Appendix to the Regulation No 63
of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences,
of 24 May 2021 on the organization of the academic year 2021/2022**

Article 1

The official inauguration of the 2021/2022 academic year will take place on 30 September 2021.

Article 2

1. As regards the full-time studies the following shall apply:

a) Teaching classes:

- winter semester 01 October 2021 - 31 January 2022

Making up for classes: 26 January 2020 - Thursday classes according to the schedule
31 January 2022 - Thursday classes according to the schedule

- summer semester 28 February 2022 - 21 June 2022

b) Exam sessions dates:

- I winter session: 1 February 2022 - 9 February 2022

- II winter (resit) session: 10 February 2022 - 18 February 2022

- III summer session: 22 June 2022 - 30 June 2022

- IV summer (resit) session: 1 September 2022 - 9 September 2022

c) Study periods:

- winter gap: 23 December 2021 - 31 December 2021

- spring gap: 15 April 2022 - 19 April 2022

d) Days off (no classes):

- 02 November 2021
- 21-25 February 2022
- 02 May 2022

e) Making up for classes (if applicable):

winter semester: 28 January 2022

summer semester: 15 June 2022

2. The decision on the organization of the last semester of 1st cycle studies ending in the winter semester, which may be shorter than 15 weeks, is to be made by the Deans in cooperation with the relevant authority of the student council, provided that the final date for graduating in the winter semester is February 18, 2022. The dates of the teaching classes and exam sessions are factors to be considered in the decisions of the Deans.

Article 3

For part-time studies, teaching classes in a given semester are planned in blocks selected from the indicated dates:

Having regard to the possibility of repeating classes by students of given years.

Article 4

1. The detailed organization of classes for a given field of study is to be determined by the Dean in cooperation with the relevant authority of the student council, and then it should be announced by the date specified in the SGGW Regulations of Study.
2. To gain the credits for the academic year it is necessary to gain credit for practical classes which should be completed by September 16, 2022.

Article 5

The detailed organization of classes for doctoral students, i.e. ..:

- 1) for doctoral studies commenced before the 2019/2020 academic year, should be established by the Heads of Studies;
- 2) for doctoral students educated at the SGGW Doctoral School in Warsaw should be established by the Head of the School.
