



**Ordinance No 52
of the Rector of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences, of 5 June 2023
on the organization of the 2023/2024 academic year**

According to Article 63(1) of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences Statute, it is hereby decreed as follows:

Article 1

The organization of the 2023/2024 academic year is hereby determined in the wording constituting appendix to the Ordinance.

Article 2

The implementation of the Ordinance has been assigned to the SGGW Deans, Vice-Deans, and Heads of SGGW organizational units.

Article 3

Supervision over the implementation of the Ordinance has been assigned to the Vice-Rector for Didactics.

Article 4

The ordinance enters into force on the day of its signing, with effect from the day of 29 September 2023.

Appendix to the Ordinance No 52

Article 1

The official ceremony of the inauguration of the 2023/2024 academic year will take place on 29 September 2023.

Article 2

1. As regards the full-time studies the following shall apply:

a) Teaching classes:

- winter semester	02 October 2023	- 24 January 2024
- summer semester	19 February 2024	- 14 June 2024
making up for classes:	10 June 2024	- Friday classes according to the schedule
	11 June 2024	- Thursday classes according to the schedule

b) Exam sessions dates:

- winter session:	25 January 2024	- 2 February
- winter (resit) session:	5 February 2024	- 9 February
- summer session:	17 June 2024	- 25 June 2024
- summer (resit) session:	5 September 2024	- 13 September 2024

c) Study periods:

- winter gap:	23 December 2023	- 1 January
- spring gap:	29 March 2024	- 3 April 2024

d) Days off (no classes):

- 31 October 2023
- 12-16 February 2024
- 02 May 2024

2. The decision on the organization of the last semester of first-cycle studies ending in the winter semester, which may be shorter than 15 weeks, is to be made by the Deans in cooperation with the relevant authority of the student council, provided that the final date for graduating in the winter semester is 9 February 2024. The dates of the teaching classes and exam sessions are

factors to be considered in the decisions of the Deans.

Article 3

For part-time studies, teaching classes in a given semester are planned in blocks selected from the indicated dates:

Having regard to the possibility of repeating classes by students in given years.

2. The date of the examination session for the last semester of the first-cycle studies ending in the winter semester should be determined by the Dean in a way that enables to set the date of defence of the diploma thesis and participate in recruitment for second-cycle studies.

Article 4

1. The detailed organization of classes for a given field of study is to be determined by the Dean in cooperation with the relevant authority of the student council, and then it should be announced by the date specified in the SGGW Study Regulations.

2. To gain the credits for the academic year it is necessary to gain credit for practical classes which should be completed by 20 September 2024.

Article 5

The detailed organization of classes for doctoral students educated at the SGGW Doctoral Schools should be established by the Heads of the Schools.
